FORMAT: The Competition is 54 holes of Stroke Play. The qualifying scores determine flight formation for the final 18 holes of the Tournament. The field shall be the 112 lowest handicap index entries.

The GEORGIA WOMEN'S AMATEUR CHAMPION shall be the competitor playing from the Championship tees with the lowest total score. Anyone with a 5.4 or lower index must play from the Championship Tees. **Anyone with a 10.0 handicap index or less may elect to play from the Championship Tees and must check the box on the application.** All other competitors will play from the forward tees. Tee selections may not be changed after the close of entries.

ELIGIBILITY: Contestants must be residents of Georgia and be members of GWGA. A player may join GWGA until the close of entry – **June 28th**.

ENTRY: The Entry Fee is \$180. A check in that amount payable to GWGA must accompany the attached completed Contestant Entry form. The fee covers the green fees, carts, bag tag, club storage, practice balls, banquet and gratuity for three tournament days.

Entries are accepted from GWGA members based on the July 1st handicap index revision.

The Contestant List will be posted on the GWGA web site (www.gwga.org). A Letter of Acceptance will be emailed or mailed.

Withdrawal BEFORE July 12th at 6:00 P.M., the total entry fee (\$180) will be refunded. Withdrawal from July 13th thru Saturday, the 24th the refund will be \$80.00. WITHDRAWAL AFTER JULY 24, THERE WILL BE NO REFUND UNLESS THERE IS A WAITING LIST.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right, at their discretion, to extend the deadline for applications. When the Field is filled, the additional entries are placed on a waiting list, numbered from lowest to highest handicap index and phoned in that order to fill vacancies created by withdrawals.

REGISTRATION: Competitors must register at the GWGA Registration Desk located in the Club Pro Shop area.
Registration hours are Monday, July 25, 9:00 AM until 2:00 PM.
Emergencies: Contact the golf shop @ 706-484-0050 and ask for GWGA Registration. An authorized individual may register for contestants, provided they supply all necessary information.

REGULATIONS: The tournament shall be played in accordance with the USGA RULES OF GOLF and Policies and Procedures established by the Georgia Women's Golf Association.

Competitors shall wear appropriate golf attire. Only non-metal spikes are permitted.

Caddies will be permitted for all contestants. Pull carts, push carts, private carts and coolers are not permitted. CELL PHONES MUST BE TURNED OFF ON THE COURSE AND PRACTICE AREAS.

The Board of Directors reserves the right to approve or reject entries and refund deposited monies at any time before and throughout the competition.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to review competitors' adjusted Georgia Women's Amateur Championship Tournament scores with regard to appropriate posting to that player's handicap records.

Distance Measuring Devices are allowed to measure distance only. The uses of devices (**including cell phones**) that gauge or measure other conditions that might affect a player's play (e.g. wind or gradient) are not permitted.

PRACTICE ROUND: The course is open for a practice round starting July 12th thru the 24th on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Sundays (after 12:00 PM). Monday, July 25th tee times are from 8:30 AM to 3:00 PM.

- Practice Areas will be open 7:30 AM to 5:00 PM.
- Call 706-484-0050 after July 1st for tee times.
- Practice round fee is \$25 (cash or credit card) payable in the golf shop. Fee includes range balls.

AWARDS:

The ELEANOR M. KEELER MEMORIAL TROPHY is awarded to the Champion.*

- The ELEANOR KEELER TROPHY is awarded to the Second Place (Runner-Up) in the Tournament.*
- The BILLIE WICKLIFFE TROPHY (formerly known as the MEDALIST TROPHY) is awarded to the competitor with the lowest qualifying score.*
- The CEIL MACLAURIN (formerly known as the GOLFER TROPHY) will be awarded to the player with the lowest 18 hole score during tournament play.*
- The BURNS CUP is awarded to the Senior (50 years or older) with the lowest qualifying score. Note: An eligible contestant must declare intent to compete for the trophy on her Entry or before registration is closed.*

AWARDS Cont.:

- The DOAK CUP is awarded to the club with two members who have the lowest aggregate qualifying score. NOTE: A contestant who is a member of more than one club must designate on her Entry the club for which she is competing and may not change that designation after the close of entry.*
- GWGA COMMEMORATIVES are awarded to the sixteen competitors who qualify for the Championship Flight.
- The HOLE IN ONE TROPHY is awarded to the contestant(s) scoring a hole in one in the competition.
- THREE PRIZES are awarded in each Flight-Winner, Second, Third.

GWGA Perpetual Trophies remain in the possession of their respective winners one year. An appropriate prize is awarded to each trophy winner.
